



Job Vacancy - Mechanical Building Services Installer, Craftsperson and Senior Craftsperson

This is a brilliant opportunity for a Mechanical Services Installer, Craftsperson and Senior Craftsperson to work as part of our growing mechanical division operating not only in the South Wales but across the UK. This position is immediately available for candidates with experience installing large scale industrial and commercial systems such as heating, chilled water, hot and cold. You will be required to work on various commercial construction sites such as student residences, schools, universities, offices and factories.

RESPONSIBILITIES

The successful candidates must have a knowledge of the commercial systems and how the components within systems relate to each other. Within your role you will be responsible to plan, organise and undertake the installation of various systems to a high standard whilst using efficient resources to do so. Allocated tasks will be given to you by the supervisor or Project Manager that you will be able to effectively complete, safely and with consideration to environmental impact using industry recognised practices.

Candidates must be able to carry out pipework fabrication, installation and jointing techniques for industrial and commercial system such as soldering, pressfit, threading and fusion welding. The installation of bracket systems for distribution systems and the positioning and assembly of plant such as boilers, air source heat pumps, storage vessels etc.

Undertake allocated work tasks in the testing, pre-commissioning, commissioning and decommissioning of industrial and commercial cold water systems, hot water systems, heating systems and chilled water systems. You must be able to demonstrate competence in the health and safety, communication, quality control and environmental requirements.

PERSONAL QUALITIES

We are seeking individuals that enthusiastic and able to follow instructions. Good time keeping and organisational skills is a must and require you to not only work as an individual but as part of the wider team.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

NVQ Level 2 or 3 in Heating and Ventilation (Commercial), Building Services Installer/Craftsperson or Plumbing Systems is desirable but not essential as previous experience in a similar role will be considered. Candidates must have an overall knowledge and good understanding of a wide variety of mechanical systems and their installation methods. You will require good time management skills, the ability to work as part of a team and have excellent attention to detail. You must have a good level of IT literacy with experience in Microsoft Office and hold a full UK driving license. Welding experience and commercial Gas Safe registration would be advantageous.

TYPICAL WORKING WEEK

The contract would be based on 37 hours per week, 8AM to 4PM Monday to Thursday and 8AM to 3PM Friday (excludes travel time) and 0.5 hour for lunch. Some occasional weekend work or overtime may feature. Not all our projects are in South Wales so we are seeking individuals that would be willing to work away, through the week. If required to work away, then lodging will be provided.
